The Jim and Peggy Curtis Scholarship Fund Re-application Instructions

ELIGIBILITY

This application is for individuals who have received funding from the Jim and Peggy Curtis Scholarship Fund in a previous year. First time applicants who will graduate from, or have graduated from, either Moffat Senior High School or Mountain Valley Senior High School in 2016, 2017, or 2018 should ask the school's guidance counselor for an application or visit <http://www.denverfoundation.org/Scholarships/For-High-School-Students> for a writable PDF version of the application.

Please note that applicants who are related to a member of the scholarship selection committee or a Denver Foundation employee or board member are not eligible to apply.

APPLICATION

For an application to be considered complete you must include the following:

- Completed application form (make sure you sign the application form)
- Personal Statement
- Transcript(s) of all completed college coursework
- Letter of Reference
- Resume (Optional)

SELECTION PROCESS

Recipients will be selected based on their motivation, goals, letter of reference, and potential for success in their chosen program. Applications will be reviewed by an independent committee. The Curtis family has established this fund to support local students, but family members do not select the scholarship recipients.

AWARDS

Up to 3 students will be awarded this year through a competitive process. This amount may be awarded to one student or divided between students. Applicants may use this scholarship to attend a trade school, a technical school, a community college, or a 4-year college. Awards can be used toward tuition and fees for full-time or part-time study. Scholarship money must be used within 2 years of the date that the student is notified that they have won an award. Awards will be paid directly to the recipient's school. *An individual can apply for and receive a scholarship award from this fund for a maximum of three years.*

DEADLINE

Applications must be postmarked or emailed by **March 15, 2019** to be considered by the Selection Committee. Applicants will be notified of the Selection Committee's decision before the end of April.
