April 2nd deadline for 2012 Colorado Press Association \$500 College Journalism Faculty Internships

Would you like to spend two weeks during the summer of 2012 at a newspaper in your community — and be paid for the experience?

If you teach journalism at a four-year college or university in Colorado, you are invited to apply for a Colorado Press Association College Journalism Faculty Internship. Up to five faculty members will be selected to participate in a two-week internship. Each participant will receive a \$500 stipend at the conclusion of the internship.

A lot of changes have occurred in the field of journalism over the last few years. This internship is designed to give college journalism professors the opportunity to meet with publishers, editors, advertising directors, and production managers to discuss current newspaper operations, technology, news-gathering, business models, and ethics.

Participants may choose to spend the two weeks in one department – newsroom or advertising, for example – or they may spend time in a number of the newspaper's department. Past participants have written stories or columns, shot photos, and designed pages or ads for the newspaper. The scope of activities will be decided by the participant and newspaper management before the start of the internship.

To Apply

Submit the following items in one packet to The Denver Foundation:

- Cover letter that details your journalism and teaching experience and describes what you would hope to gain from an internship
- Completed Application Form
- Current resume

Deadline

Application packets must be postmarked by **Monday, April 2, 2012**. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered. Applicants will be notified on or before May 8th regarding the Selection Committee's decisions.
